10th BAAL Language, Gender and Sexuality SIG Meeting Language, Discrimination and Conflict Call for papers

There is an ongoing need, both within and beyond the field of language, gender and sexuality, to address issues of discrimination and conflict as they are played out through language. At this event, we will explore the ways in which language can ignite and perpetuate discriminatory practices, yet can also be a vehicle through which such discrimination can be resisted or challenged. We will also consider how conflict between opposing groups or norms associated with gender and/or sexuality may be linguistically constructed, rationalised, and defused. We aim to bring together a range of researchers interested in issues of language, discrimination and conflict in relation to gender and/or sexuality, and to explore possible ways in which these issues can be addressed. This one-day event will include presentations by two invited speakers, a selection of paper presentations, and opportunities for discussion.

- Discourses of violence and abuse
- Sexist, transphobic, and homophobic discrimination
- Conflicting identities and ideologies
